## **Phase III of Tree Inventory Complete**

The preservation and conservation of Wildwood's wonderful natural environment is one (1) of the five (5) major elements of this community's Master Plan. Since incorporation, a number of regulations have been developed to address the protection of the City's natural environment, which emphasizes the importance of this effort.

The City believes the identification of trees located within the public rights-of-way is beneficial to maintaining the natural environment and allows it to develop a plan for their maintenance, retention, and replacement, so they can continue to be an asset to the residents of this community for years to come. To this end, the City has been conducting a Street Tree Inventory of its public rights-of-way. This inventory has been completed in phases, with the majority of last phase (Phase III), funded through the Missouri Department of Conservation's Tree Resource Improvement and Maintenance (TRIM) program.

The City takes great pride in its urban forest and has a desire to develop an Urban Forestry Management Report in order to create and support a long-term and sustainable management program, and this on-going process will assist in the achievement of this goal.
