Since Fall 2007, the Department of Planning has been working with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources-Groundwater Section on the installation of monitoring wells in the rural areas of the City that have recently experienced problems with their water sources. The selected locations for these two (2) wells are an unimproved City right-of-way located near the Hencken Road/State Route 100 intersection and Babler State Park (northwest area). The purpose of these wells are to provide data to the State and the City on the condition of the groundwater resource and how it is being affected by growth in Wildwood and surrounding areas.
