Discussion was held regarding: contested and uncontested cases; exhaustion of administrative remedies; ample time to present cases at the Commission level; waiving requirements on conditional use permits; process of bringing an appeal forward; hearing processes for protests; should the committee be removed from the hearing process for protests; clarification of protest versus appeal; referral of recommendations from City Council to Committees; should super majority vote be required by the City Council to refer recommendations to Committees; remove redundancy; balance between allowing public input and improving efficiently; could referrals be sent to the Development Review Committee; should a motion be made to postpone items until a future meeting instead of referring to a Committee; protests will no longer have a hearing but at City Council level; identify different officers listed in the hearing process; discussion of notices to take place at next meeting.
