



# WILDWOOD ELECTION INFORMATION APRIL 2020 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Starting Saturday, November 2, 2019, signatures may be obtained on Nominating Petitions for the April 7, 2020 General Municipal Election.

## **Election Information - April 7, 2020 Election**

Filing **OPENS** on **Tuesday, December 17, 2019** at 8:00 a.m.

The City Clerk shall receive all candidates, during regular office hours, in the order in which they pass through the front door of City Hall, until filing closes.

Filing **CLOSES** on **Tuesday, January 21, 2020** at 5:00 p.m.

No candidate's name shall be printed on any official ballot unless the candidate has filed a written Declaration of Candidacy and paid a ten dollar (\$10.00) filing fee to the City Clerk. Payment of the filing fee may be by cash or check made payable to: the City of Wildwood, Missouri.

## **Do you want to be Mayor in the City of Wildwood (4-Year Term)?**

### **You must meet the following Qualifications for Mayor:**

- \* A registered voter;
- \* At least twenty-five (25) years old; and
- \* A resident of the City for at least two (2) years prior to election and during the term of office.

## **Do you want to be a City Council Member in the City of Wildwood (2-Year Term)?**

### **You must meet the following Qualifications for a Council Member:**

- \* A registered voter; and
- \* A resident of the Ward for one (1) year prior to election and during the term of office.

## **Nominating Petitions:**

Candidates for Mayor and Council Member must submit completed Nominating Petitions on forms provided by the City Clerk. Petitions for the office of Mayor shall be signed by not less than one hundred (100) registered voters of that City. Petitions for the office of Council Member shall be signed by not less than twenty-five (25) registered voters who are residents of the ward in which the candidate is nominated. Completed Nominating Petitions must be submitted at the time of filing of a Declaration of Candidacy.

Petition signatures shall be valid only if obtained not earlier than forty-five (45) days prior to the first day of filing. Therefore, ***Any Signatures Obtained Prior to Saturday, November 2, 2019, Are Invalid.*** No person shall be allowed to be nominated for more than one (1) office at a time.
